Sept 13: The Day of Atonement by David Liss, an historical fiction that takes place in 18th century Portugal. *Hybrid Meeting*

Oct 11: The Last Rose of Shanghai by Weina Dai Randel, a novel set during World War II, when some Jews escaped to Japanese-occupied Shanghai. *Zoom Meeting*

Dec: 13 Lot Six by David Adjmi - A memoir by a gay man born into a Conservative Syrian Jewish community in Brooklyn, **Lot Six** charts the author's search for belonging, identity, and what it takes to be an artist in America. *Zoom Meeting*

Jan: 10 People Love Dead Jews by Dara Horn – Essays exploring how Jewish history has been exploited (this book was mentioned by several folks). *Zoom Meeting*

Mar 14: Florence Adler Swims Forever by Rachel Beanland – Based on a true story, this family saga is set in Atlantic City, 1930. *Hybrid Meeting*

April 11: Atomic Anna by Rachel Barenbaum – An epic adventure of three generations of women traveling through time to prevent the Chernobyl meltdown. *Hybrid Meeting*
