  - **Passover Giftbag Making & Delivery:** Create and deliver Passover giftbags to members of the Seattle community on Sunday, March 26. Volunteers meet at the JFS Capitol Hill location at the start of their assigned shift for giftbag assembly and community education before delivering giftbags to their assigned routes.   - **Create Passover Cards:** Create your own cards with as much creativity and color as possible. We love to see Happy Passover messages and drawings, but we ask that you don't sign your name or include any personal information on the cards. Make sure to get us your cards by **Friday, March 24**, so we can include them in our gift bags! Cards can be dropped off at JFS (1601 16<sup>th</sup> Ave, Seattle, WA 98122) during office hours, which are Mon-Fri, 10am-1pm and 2-5pm or mailed in addressed ATTN: Pasover Cards.
  - **General Event Support:** We are looking for volunteers who would like to assist with our in-person volunteer events. These shifts would be on select Fridays and Sundays and are a great way to support JFS! Duties could include event material preparation, leading hands on workstations, assisting with check in, and general set-up and clean up. Some heavy lifting may be involved.
- **Friendly Visitor:** Our Older Adult Services team is in search of Friendly Visitor volunteers to offer social support to older adults.
- **Refugee Support:** Our Refugee and Immigrant Services team is working to build our on-call list. Tasks might include storage organizing, grocery delivery, apartment set-up, and more.
- **Shabbat Meal Delivery Substitute:** Twice a month, volunteers deliver Shabbat meals to JFS clients. Volunteer shifts are on Fridays and involve picking up meals from the University District between 9am-11am and then delivering meals directly to clients. Substitutes will fill in as they are available when volunteers are sick or on vacation.
- **Food Bank Support:** Our Food Bank team has a couple of volunteer openings. See below for details.
  - **On-Call Volunteers:** Our Food Bank team is looking for on-call volunteers to help out on an as-needed basis. Volunteer shifts are Wednesdays and Fridays from 10am-12pm and Thursdays from 2pm-4pm. On-call volunteers will be contacted when substitutes are needed and will fill in as available.
  - **Home Delivery Volunteer:** Our Food Bank team is looking to fill three home delivery volunteer roles: one delivering to Capitol Hill, one delivering to Lake City/Northgate, and one to act as a substitute and make monthly deliveries to homes throughout the Seattle area. Shifts are available the second Sunday of the month, Mondays, and Wednesdays.
